The City of Lincoln will hold a public open house to provide pre-construction information regarding storm drainage improvements and pavement preservations intended to reconstruct drainage structures and improve the driving surface of the roadway. The project is expected to start on May 30th and be completed by the end of September. The purpose of this project is to maintain and improve the driving surface of the existing roadway. Repair is needed based on an overall condition rating and visual inspections conducted by City staff. Construction will include repairing or replacing deteriorated concrete base, curb, milling and replacing the asphalt surface. Other work includes replacing damaged storm drainage structures and inlet tops, impacted sidewalks, and reconstructing curb ramps to adhere to requirements set forth by the Americans with Disability Act (ADA).

Please come anytime between 4:30 - 6:00 PM as there will not be a formal presentation. Parking is available on the east side of the building and the building is handicap accessible.
